



SaskExpress Studio 2022-2023 Fee Information

Please Note: In the event of any studio closures due to unforeseeable acts of God, previously collected tuition fees are non-refundable.

1. DISCOUNTS

MULTI-STUDENT (FAMILY) DISCOUNT

This discount will be applied to the child(ren) whose total fees are equal to or less than that of the first child.

Example: Sibling 1 is registered in a 1-hour class; sibling 2 is registered in a 45-minute class. Sibling 2 receives 10% off his/her monthly fees.

- 2nd child – 10%
- 3rd child – 15%
- 4th + child – 20%

MULTI-CLASS DISCOUNT

This discount will be applied to students enrolled in multiple classes and is based on the number of classes per student (not per family).

- 1 – 3 Classes: No discount
- 4 – 5 Classes: 5% discount
- 6 + Classes: 10% discount

Please Note: Discount is not applicable to the Mini Express & The Expressions fee.

2. FEES

ADMINISTRATION FEE

This is a one-time administration fee collected at the time of registration. Early bird discounts are available (please see www.saskexpress.com for details).

- \$50 per student

CLASS FEES

Class tuition fees are based on class length and charged on the 1st of every month from September – June. Fees are calculated based on the entire year of classes and charged over 9 and a half months: equal payments September through May, and a half month’s payment in June due to the mid-month ending of the season.

COSTUME FEES

Costume fees are inclusive of all costs associated with each costume, including duties and import fees, taxes, shipping, exchange, alterations, and the price of the costume. Costume deposits are charged on November 15 and will be credited towards the costume ordered for each class. **As this fee is a deposit, families are responsible to pay any remaining balance when the costume arrives.** These invoices will be distributed in May.

Please Note: Deposit is per costume and is **non-refundable after November 15.**

Solos/Duos/Extra Groups	\$100 for female-identifying; \$75 for male-identifying

PICTURE FEES

Students will receive a professional individual and group photo for every class they are enrolled in at the end of the year. This **non-refundable** fee is charged per class on November 15.

- \$20/class. For classes having multiple dances (Level 3 Dance Combo, Level 4 Dance Combo, Inter/Senior Lyrical & Contemporary etc.) each student will be charged \$20/routine.
- \$40 for dancers enrolled in Level 2 Ballet/Tap classes, as these students receive 2 photos (1 for tap and 1 for ballet).

COMPETITION FEES

- **New this year!** All recreational dancers (Level 2 and up) will be attending SaskExpress' Stars of Tomorrow Dance Festival as honoured "Stars of Tomorrow" performers. Dancers will receive professional adjudicator feedback and keepsakes. Recreational dancers will be charged the associated entry fees on December 10th for entry into Stars of Tomorrow Dance Festival.
- Competitive students will be charged a **\$25 deposit/competitive class** on both September 25 and October 25 to offset competition entry fees. Students participating in solos, duos, or extra competitive group numbers will be charged a one-time deposit of **\$50/number** on October 25, after sign-up for these routines has been completed. Invoices for any outstanding competition entry fees will be distributed in December; payment options for outstanding amounts are TBD.
- Students participating in extra competitive numbers (solos, duos, or extra groups) will receive an invoice for choreography at the end of October. Payment will be charged on December 10.

Please Note: Competition choreography and entry fees (including deposits) are **non-refundable**.

EXAM FEES

Exam classes are offered for competitive students. Students entering exams will be invoiced upon entry for an exam. Payment is **non-refundable**.

Please Note: Should a student be unable to take an exam due to medical reasons, they may be eligible to receive a partial refund from the examining body if they have provided SaskExpress with a doctor's note.

FEE POLICIES

- From September – June, fees will be charged to the credit card or bank account on file.
- A \$25 handling fee will be charged for any NSF payments. A monthly service charge of 10% will be charged on all outstanding accounts.
- Families with any outstanding tuition balances will be unable to incur additional expenses (ie. studio apparel, extra costumes, show tickets, etc.).
- Families with any outstanding fees of any kind may be restricted from participating in studio classes and activities at the discretion of studio management.
